On this occasion a special lecture will be delivered by Prof. (Dr.) Jatin Kumar Das, Professor, Department of Law, University of Calcutta.



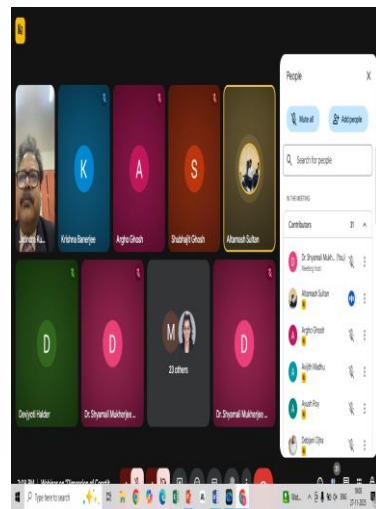
