(Observance of Constitution Day)- 2021

The Constitution Day, also known as 'Samvidhan Divas' is celebrated on 26th November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India by the Constituent Assembly of India on 26th November 1949, which came into effect from 26th January 1950. It celebrates India's democratic values and promotes awareness of justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity.

In 2015, the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment declared 26th November as Constitution Day to deepen citizens' connection with the Constitution. Before 2015, 26th November was observed as National Law Day. The day honours the Constituent Assembly's vision in drafting the Constitution and Dr B.R. Ambedkar's pivotal role as Chairman of the Drafting Committee, earning him the title "Father of the Indian Constitution."
