### **About the Program:**

Surendranath Law College organized an International webinar on the topic of “Engendering Laws and Crimes against Women: Challenges and Projections in the Globalized World” on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> May 2022. Total 50 participants registered for the webinar through google form. Engendering Law intends to provide special provisions to address the issue of discrimination based on sex and gender. Atrocities against women in India, are clearly found in the age-old religious and cultural practices. In the Vedic period women had equal standing in society with that of a man. But later, during medieval period their position has been deteriorated. Through this seminar we have analysed the various crimes that are committed especially against women in our male dominated society where women have to face discrimination and violence from her birth till death. It also focuses on various laws and measures which have been taken by government for the welfare of the fair sex.

### **Objectives of the Webinar:**

1. To explore all the sociological and legal aspects of crimes committed against women.
2. To understand the intricacies of different law related to women’s right like PWDVA, PC, ITPA, Sexual harassment at workplace, Criminal Law Act and any other.
3. To discuss prominent judgements and case law in favour of gender justice
4. To deliberate on the obstacles and challenges to the criminal justice system in India that promises to eradicate crimes against women

### **Outcomes of the Webinar:**

1. To create awareness and sensitization about different types of crimes against women
2. To indicate the prominent challenges faced by the legal system in handling issues related to crimes against women.
3. To identify the main procedural and substantive lapses that have an impact on gender-just laws
4. To recommended legal reforms that establish the constitutional mandate of gender equality.
