Admission

1. Q: What are the eligibility criteria for admission to the undergraduate law programme?

A: Candidates must have passed the 10+2 examination or its equivalent.
For General at least 45% marks in best four subjects and at least 40% marks in best four subjects for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PWD.

2. Q: What is the admission process for the LL.B. programme?

A: Admission is based on the merit list position of the candidate at the entrance examination and Counselling session conducted by the University of Calcutta.

3. Q: Are there any age restrictions for applying to the LL.B. course?

A: There is no upper age limit for admission to the LL.B. programme.

4. Q: How can I apply for the LL.B./LL.M programme?

A: Applications can be submitted online through the official website of University of Calcutta against the admission notification published by the University.

5. Q: Is there any entrance exam for admission to the postgraduate law programme (LL.M.)?

A: Yes, admission to postgraduate law programme (LL.M.) is based on the entrance exam conducted by University of Calcutta.

6. Q: What documents are required during the admission process?

A: Required documents include the 10+2 Mark Sheet/LL.B. Mark Sheet, Transfer Certificate, Character Certificate, Admit Card of Madhyamik or equivalent, etc. (Please follow detailed notification issued in the College Website).

7. Q: Is there a reservation policy for SC/ST/OBC candidates?

A: Yes, the college follows the reservation policy as per the guidelines of the University of Calcutta and the Government of West Bengal.

8. Q: What is the fee structure for the LL.B. programme?

A: The fee structure is subject to change and a detailed fee structure is available in the official website of college.

9. Q: Is fee concession available for students?

A: Yes, for details of fee concession policy of Surendranath Law College, follow the College Website.

10.Q: What are the weekly holidays?

A: Every Sunday and every Second and Fourth Saturdays of the month are holidays.

Courses

11.Q: What are the different law programmes offered at Surendranath Law College?

A: The college offers B.A.LL.B. (Five Years), B.A.LLB. (Honours) and LL.M.

12.Q: What are the specializations available in the LL.M. programme in Surendranath Law College?

A: (i) Business Law and (ii) Tort and Crime.

13.Q: What are the syllabus for the LL.B. and LL.M. Programmes?

A: The syllabus is prescribed by University of Calcutta. Detailed syllabus and course structure is available in the college website.

14.Q: What is the medium of instruction for the law programmes?

A: The medium of instruction is English.

15.Q: What opportunities are available for practical training in law?

A: Practical training includes internships, moot courts, legal aid clinics, and court visits.

Library Use

16.Q: What are the library hours?

A: On working days the college library is open from 8:00 AM to 2.15 PM. Online resources can be accessed remotely by students and faculty members.

17.Q: How can I get a library membership?

A: Students can obtain library membership by registering with their student ID and paying a nominal fee.

18.Q: Are there any late fees for overdue books?

A: Yes, a late fee is charged for overdue books as per the college library policy.

19.Q: Is there a reading room available in the library?

A: Yes, the library has a dedicated reading room for students.

20.Q: Are there any digital resources available in the library?

A: Yes, the library offers a range of digital resources including e-books, e-journals, and online databases.

21.Q: How can I access the library's catalogue?

A: The library catalog can be accessed online through the Koha software..

22.Q: Are there any library orientation programmes for new students?

A: Yes, the library conducts orientation programmes for new students at the beginning of each academic session.

Faculty

23.Q: What are the qualifications of the faculty members?

A: Faculty members are appointed on the basis of recommendation of WBCSC and/or Government of West Bengal and possess qualification as per UGC norms and/or government norms.

Faculty members hold advanced degrees including doctorate degrees in law and non-law subjects like English, Political Science, Economics, and Sociology and have significant academic and professional experience.

A: Yes, the college regularly invites visiting faculty from reputed institutions.

25.Q: How can I contact my professors outside of class hours?

A: Professors can be contacted via official email or during their office hours.

26.Q: Does the college provide mentorship programmes?

A: Yes, the college offers mentorship programmes where faculty members guide and mentor students.

27.Q: How does the college ensure quality teaching?

A: The college ensures quality teaching through regular training programmes, workshops, and feedback mechanisms.
