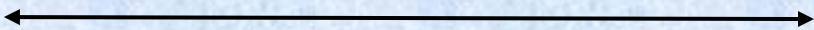
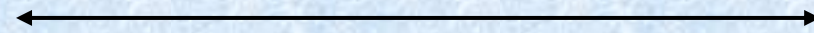

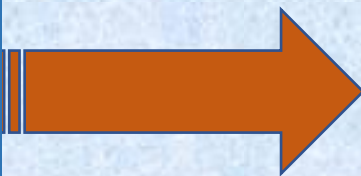

## WORKSHOP ON MOOT COURT

**A Moot Court Simulates A Real Court Environment (Usually An Appeal Against A Final Decision ), In Which Participants Analyse A Problem, Research The Relevant Law , Prepare Written Submissions And Present Their Arguments. Moot Courts Are Designed To Give Law Students An Opportunity To Put Their Legal Education Into Practice. Moot Problems Are Typically Set In Areas Of Law That Are Unsettled Or That Have Been Subject To Recent Developments. They Usually Involve Two Grounds Of Appeal, Argued By Each Side. Mooting Is Not The Same As Public Speaking Or Debating, Although It Shares Some Common Elements With These Activities. It Is A Specialised Application Of The Art Of Persuasive Advocacy. It Has Been Part Of The Process Of Training Lawyers For Centuries And Plays An Important Role In Legal Education, Not Only In India, But Also Throughout The World.**
