- Preliminary Round: Written test to shortlist 24 participants

- Semi-Finals: 4 teams selected – 2 from SNU, 1 from SNLC, 1 from Xavier's
- Finals:
  - 1st Place – St. Xavier's University (₹9000)
  - 2nd Place – Sister Nivedita University (₹7000)
  - 3rd Place – Surendranath Law College (₹3000)

1. Key features of BNS, BNSS, and BSA
2. Comparison of IPC and BNS
3. Rights of accused and victims
4. Hypothetical case studies
5. Recent amendments and landmark judgments

## Our Team's Experience:

From Surendranath Law College, 10 students from 2nd to 5th year participated. One of our teams made it to the finals and secured the 3rd position, winning a cash prize of ₹3000. The participants exhibited commendable performance and critical legal understanding under pressure.
