



Webinar On Celebration of International Human Rights Day -2021

Human Rights Day is celebrated every year on 10th December which is dedicated to promote protection of fundamental rights and freedom of all individuals. The Universal Declaration of Human Rights was adopted on this day in 1948. The celebration of Human Rights Day aims to spread awareness about human rights education among the youth and the significance of promoting the values of equality, justice and dignity from an early age. The day reaffirms the importance of committing towards safeguarding human dignity for the nation and its citizens. Human Rights Day's origin can be traced back to the aftermath of World War II when a drafting committee was appointed under the chairmanship of Eleanor Roosevelt to ensure such wars and atrocities would not occur again. This led to the adoption of Universal declaration of Human Rights on 10th December 1948 eventually being formally established in 1950 by resolution of United Nations General Assembly.
