Surendranath Law College is an esteemed Law college, affiliated with Calcutta University in 1885, imparting UG education since 1885. Being one of the oldest

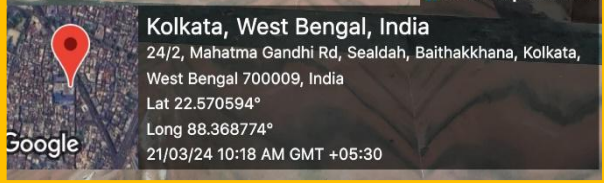
