### **Objectives of this Lecture Series:**

3. **Strengthen Understanding of Legal Documentation and Procedures:** The program sought to deepen students' understanding of the technicalities involved in legal documentation, property transfers, and court procedures, making them proficient in managing legal matters both in litigation and transactional law.

## **Program Details:**

Faculty members, along with guest speakers from the legal profession, delivered insightful lectures and practical exercises to engage students.

## **Key Highlights:**

22nd & 23rd March 2022: The series opened with introductory sessions on Legal Drafting by senior faculty members. These sessions emphasized the fundamentals of drafting and the importance of precision in legal documents.

24th to 27th March 2022: Students engaged in more detailed exercises in Advanced Legal Drafting. These sessions covered topics like drafting contracts,

agreements, and affidavits, allowing students to understand real-world applications of legal writing.

29th & 30th March 2022: The focus shifted to Pleading, where students learned the structure and components of pleadings, including petitions, complaints, and written statements used in legal proceedings.

2nd April 2022: This session concentrated on the basics of Conveyancing, introducing students to property law and the drafting of deeds and agreements related to real estate transactions.

4th to 8th April 2022: These sessions provided students with practical exercises in Drafting Deeds and Agreements. Students participated in drafting assignments, covering areas such as property sales, transfers, and legal documentation for business transactions.

27th to 30th April 2022: The final series of sessions delved deeper into Practical Court Pleadings and Mock Court Exercises. Students took part in mock drafting and courtroom practice, where they applied their knowledge to real-world scenarios, including filing petitions and preparing pleadings for hypothetical cases.

The special lecture series successfully achieved its objectives, providing students with a thorough understanding of drafting, pleading, and conveyance. The practical exercises allowed students to gain hands-on experience in preparing legal documents, framing court pleadings, and drafting property transfer documents.

### **Student Engagement:**

- Active participation from students in drafting exercises and discussions.



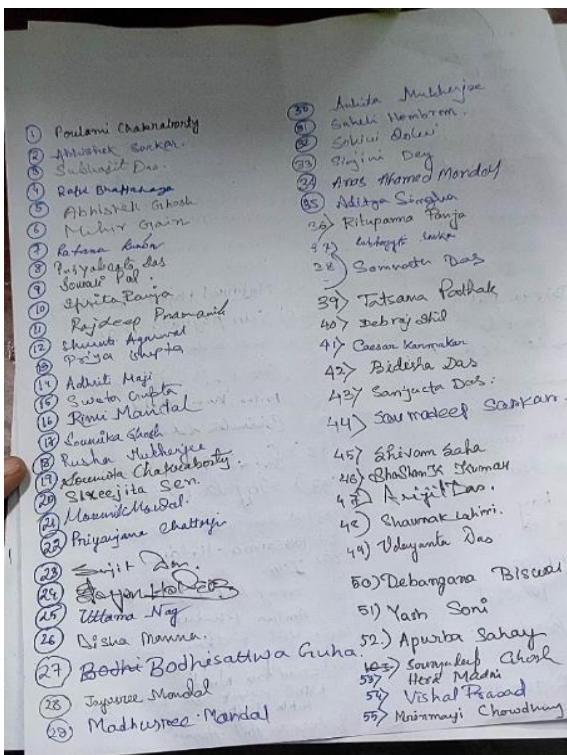
