

Special Lecture on Alternative Dispute Resolutions - 2017

The traditional mode of dispute resolution i.e. litigation is a lengthy process leading to unnecessary delays in dispensation of justice as well as over-burdening the judiciary. In such a scenario, Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) offer better and timely solution for resolution of a dispute. Alternative dispute resolution (ADR) refers to any method of [resolving disputes](#) without formal [litigation](#). Alternative dispute resolution reorients all processes and techniques of conflict resolution that occur outside of any [governmental authority](#). The most popular ADR mechanisms include arbitration, mediation, conciliation and negotiation. All ADR methods have common characteristics – i.e., enabling the parties to find admissible solutions to their conflicts outside of traditional legal / court proceedings, but are governed by different rules. In India, one of the most popular modes of ADR is arbitration, conducted as per the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

To raise academic awareness and professional expertise about the applicability of alternative dispute resolution methods , Surendranath Law College organized a Special Lecture on this issue on 18/11/2017 which was delivered by eminent lawyer practicing Calcutta High Court, Advocate Swapan Pathak . This lecture served the purpose of disseminating knowledge about the various aspects of ADR mechanisms which are being implemented in India to the final semester batch (10th Semester) students who are on the verge of commencing their professional legal careers.
