The United Nations General Assembly declared June 5 as World Environment Day during the Stockholm Conference on the Human Environment, held in Stockholm, Sweden, in 1972. It was the first world conference to make environmental protection a major issue. World Environment Day was celebrated for the first time in 1973 under the theme '**Only One Earth**'. Since then, it has grown into a global platform involving all U.N. Member States. World Environment Day is a global event celebrated every year on June 5th. It is an initiative led by the United Nations (UN). It is a special day observed worldwide to focus on environmental issues. It helps raise awareness and promote action for the protection of the environment. It serves as a platform for communities to come together and address environmental challenges.
