In 1991 The U.N. General Assembly Adopted The U.N. Principles For Older Persons Which Aims To Ensure That Prioritised Attention Is Given To The Needs And Problems Faced By The Elderly Population. According To The National Commission On Population, The Share Of The Elderly In India's Population, Close To 9% In 2011, Is Growing Fast And May Reach 18% By 2036. The Un World Population Ageing Report Notes That India's Ageing Population (Those Aged 60 And Above) Is Projected To Increase To Nearly 20% By 2050 From About 8% At Present , Making Them The Fastest-Growing Age Group In India. With This Future In Mind, It Is Essential That Our Policy Framework And Social Responses Are Directed To Tackle This Reality.

Indian society is undergoing a fundamental transformation under the impacts of globalization induced neo liberal economic policies, rapid urbanization and the increasing proliferation of technological changes. The traditional joint family system has largely broken down giving rise to nuclear families, where the elderly members are often neglected, both financially and emotionally and are viewed as a liability. The growing number of old age homes in our society are a grim reminder that india's traditional social values of respecting and caring for the elderly is now giving way to their abandonment where this vulnerable section of the population is left to grapple with loneliness, and a sense economic disempowerment .

In Old Age Homes, The Care Of Elderly People Is Managed By A Set Of Professionals Or Voluntary Organisations Interested In Geriatric Services. The Number Of Such Care Homes Is Rising Rapidly In Urban And Semi-Urban India. These Homes Are Either Paid For, Or Offer Free Or Subsidised Service. Typically, Such Homes Are Run By Ngos, Religious Or Voluntary Organisations With Support From The Government, Or By Local Philanthropists. They Provide Accommodation, Timely Care, And A Sense Of Security For Their Residents.

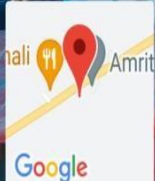

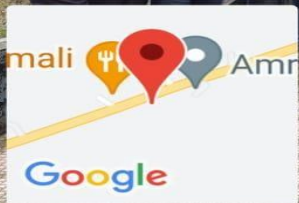
