

- Participation Across the College Community:

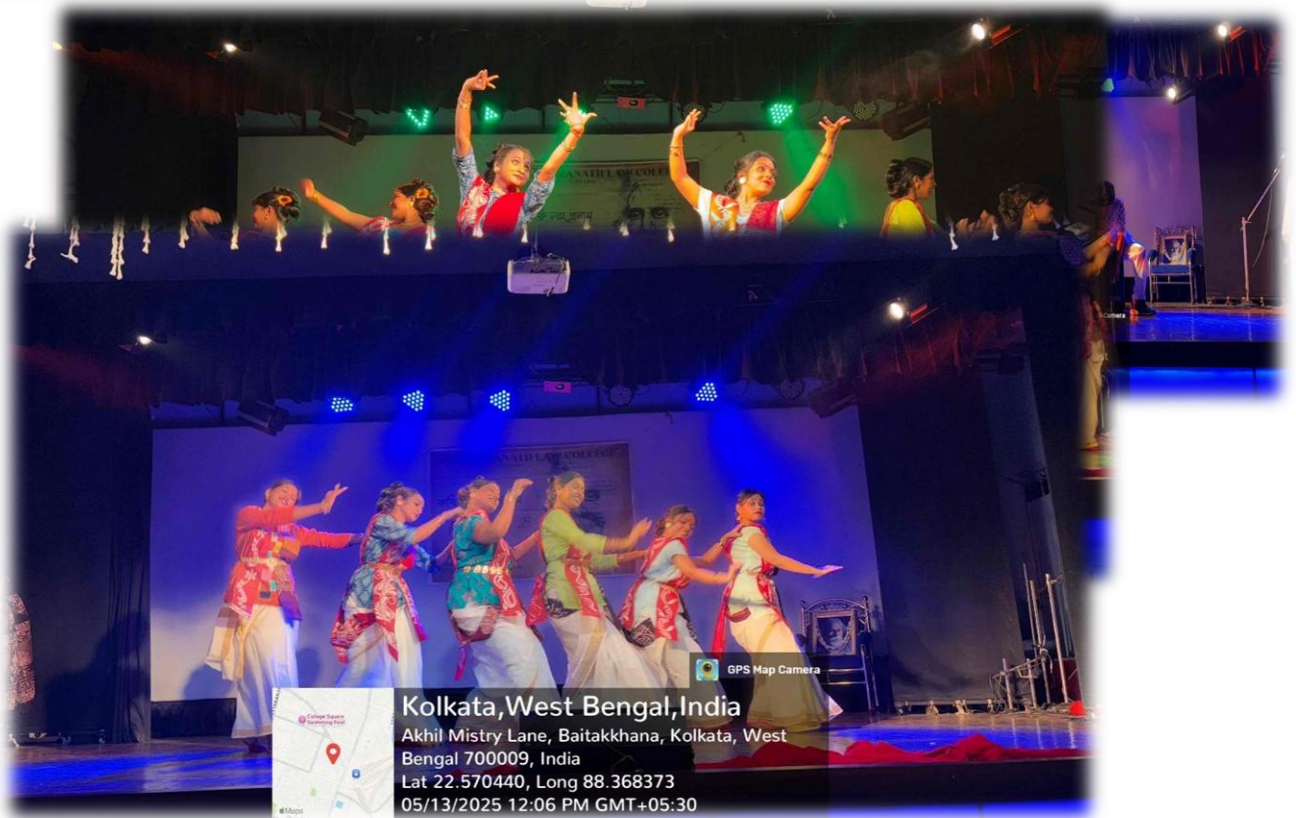
