ABOUT COLLEGE:

Surendranath Law College is an esteemed law institute affiliated to the University of Calcutta and recognized by the Bar Council of India, also regarded as one of the oldest law colleges of the country. 'Rastraguru' Surendranath Banerjee, the great patriot and educationist founded this college in the heart of the city close to the Sealdah Station - considering the convenience of commuting and to encourage more students to partake of quality education, especially for those who belonged to the downtrodden community. In 1882, the Presidency School, which formed the nucleus of the present Institution, was handed over to Sir Surendranath Banerjea on 1st January 1884. He raised it to the status of a college affiliated to the F.A. standard and named it "The Presidency Institution". Within a year the institution was converted into a full-fledged, first grade college under the name "Ripon College". Its activity was further extended through the opening of the Post-Graduate Department of Law in 1884, which was later affiliated to the Calcutta University in the year 1885, as an independent professional college. Presently, Surendranath Law College imparts 5 years B.A.LL.B. course, 5 years B.A. LL.B. (Honors) course and two years LL.M. course.

It is a privilege for us to learn from the expertise of our respected dignitaries about the intricate issues affecting the transgender community, particularly in relation to their mental health and well-being.

OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAMME

- To provide a supportive, confidential and non-judgemental environment for students to address mental health concerns, promote emotional well-being, enhance academic success and foster a positive and inclusive campus community.
- To promote mental health awareness, reduce stigma and encourage help-seeking behaviour of the students.
- To empower students to manage severe stress, build resilience, loneliness, creating a favourable environment to express their fear, unexpressed tension and achieve their full potential.
- Through discussions on the issues and mental health concerns of the transgender community, this program aims to raise awareness among students about their own mental health as well as the others

and encourage open conversation with faculty members, fostering a supportive and inclusive environment.

PROGRAMME DETAILS

On November 26, 2024, a Psychological Counselling Seminar was held at the Seminar Hall of Surendranath Law College, attended by approximately 100 students and 18 faculty members. The seminar commenced with an enlightening lecture by esteemed speaker, Mrittika Chatterjee, Member, Protection Cell for Transgender persons, Hooghly District, who initiated the discussion on the topic of Transgender, shedding light on the complexities and nuances surrounding the transgender community. Transgender persons are individuals whose gender identity or expression differs from the sex assigned to them at birth. Gender identity refers to a person's internal, deeply-held sense of being male, female, or something else. For transgender people, their gender identity does not align with the sex they were assigned at birth.

Transgender persons may identify as:

- Male-to-Female (MTF): Assigned male at birth, but identify as female
- Female-to-Male (FTM): Assigned female at birth, but identify as male
- Non-Binary: Identify as neither exclusively male nor female, or as a combination of both
- Genderqueer: Identify as outside the traditional male/female binary
- Genderfluid: Experience different gender identities at different times

Transgender persons may or may not choose to transition, which can involve social, medical, or surgical changes to align their physical appearance with their gender identity. Being transgender is not a mental disorder, but rather a normal variation of

human identity and expression.

Next, Soma Roy Karmakar, Developmental Consultant took the stage, delivering a poignant speech that shed light on the myriad challenges faced by the transgender community. She began by narrating the struggles of transgender individuals, from social ostracism and discrimination to lack of access to education, employment, and healthcare. She emphasized the urgent need for inclusive policies, social acceptance, and empathy towards transgender individuals, highlighting the importance of creating a supportive environment that enables them to thrive and reach their full potential.

After listening to the insightful presentations by Mrittika Chatterjee and Soma Roy, it is clear that the transgender community faces numerous challenges that affect their mental health, well-being, and overall quality of life. Both speakers emphasized the importance of creating a supportive and inclusive environment that acknowledges the dignity and worth of every individual, regardless of their gender identity or expression. Overall, the presentations highlighted the urgent need for collective action to promote the rights, dignity, and well-being of transgender individuals. By working together, we can create a more inclusive and supportive society that values diversity and promotes equality for all.

The seminar on Transgender Persons' mental health served as a catalyst for students to reflect on their own mental health and well-being. By gaining a deeper understanding of the challenges faced by Transgender Persons, students developed empathy and awareness about the importance of promoting inclusivity and acceptance.



The programme is mandatory for the students of 5th and 7th Semester of Surendranath Law College.


