Every year Human Rights Day is celebrated on 10th December all around the world. On that day, the United Nations General Assembly adopted, in 1948, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) which rights established a set of common basic values both with regard to the view of human beings and to the relationship between the state and the individual. Human Rights refer to those rights which are inherent to all human beings irrespective of race, sex, nationality, ethnicity language, religion or social status. They include right to life, personal liberty freedom from slavery and torture, freedom of opinion and expression, the right to work and education, and many more. The UDHR's significance transcends its non-binding status, having served as a catalyst for over seventy human rights treaties globally. Its influence is evident in movements such as decolonization, anti-apartheid, and various freedom struggles worldwide. The UDHR, together with the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and its two Optional Protocols (on the complaints procedure and on the death penalty) and the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and its Optional Protocol, form the so-called International Bill of Human Rights.

In view of celebrating the Human Rights Day, Surendranath Law College, organized Webinar on the topic "Human Rights for Sustainable Development and Peace" on 12th December, 2022 through Zoon Online Platform. The session was addressed by **Professor (Dr.) K. C. Raval**, Director, University School of Law, Gujrat University, Ahmedabad. Near about 80 students and Faculty Members from the Colleges participated in this webinar. This webinar was Chaired by Dr. **Mohammadi Tarannum**, Vice-Principal of the Surendranath Law College. The webinar highlighted the critical relation between an effective human rights institutionalization and protection mechanism and the goal of attaining holistic sustainable development in any society pertaining to social, environmental and economic domains.
